THE SHORT VERSION

StudentTeachers runs free, hands-on career workshops for students, and we are looking for safe community spaces to host them. We are asking for a room on a weekend, nothing more. We bring the program, the materials, the volunteers, and the snacks. This guide walks through exactly how a partnership works and, just as importantly, how we keep every student safe while we are in your space.

How hosting works

It is genuinely simple. You provide the space, we provide the program. Here is the full split so there are no surprises.

We bring

- ✦ A planned, hands-on workshop (about 1.5 to 2 hours)
- ✦ Trained high-school volunteers to run it
- ✦ All activity materials and supplies
- ✦ Snacks for the students
- ✦ A guest speaker when the topic fits
- ✦ Sign-up and safety paperwork, handled before the day

You provide

- ✦ A room for a couple of hours on a weekend
- ✦ Tables, chairs, and ideally a screen
- ✦ Help spreading the word to local families
- ✦ A staff contact reachable during the event

What it costs you

Nothing. There is no fee, no catch, and no long-term commitment. We are a free program and hosting us is free too. You are lending a room for a few hours and getting a community event in return.

Why hosting is an easy yes

Opening your space to us is not just a favor. It is a low-effort way to do something good for the families you already serve.

It serves your community

A free, enriching weekend event for local kids, hosted right in your building. Exactly the kind of programming families remember and appreciate.

It is zero work for your staff

We plan it, run it, and clean up after ourselves. Your only job on the day is having one contact reachable. We handle the rest.

It fills your space with purpose

An empty weekend room becomes a place where kids discover what they might want to do with their lives. A good use of a quiet Saturday.

It reflects well on you

Hosting youth education is the kind of community partnership schools and libraries are proud to point to.

How we keep students safe

This is the part that matters most to you, and to us. We take student safety seriously and we have clear rules that apply at every single workshop, in every space we use. Here is exactly what that looks like.

An adult is always present

Our volunteer team is made up of high schoolers, so **we never operate without an adult in the loop**. Every workshop has a responsible adult present and reachable, whether that is one of our adult organizers, a parent volunteer, or your own on-site staff contact. Students are never supervised by minors alone.

Consent and sign-up for every student

- ✦ **Signed parent or guardian consent.** No student attends without a parent or guardian signing them up first. We handle this before the event, not at your front door.
- ✦ **Emergency and medical info.** Every sign-up collects an emergency contact and any allergy or medical notes, so we are prepared.
- ✦ **Photo permission is opt-in.** We only photograph students whose parents have explicitly said yes.

Clear supervision rules

- ✦ **Never one-on-one.** A volunteer is never alone with a student out of sight of another volunteer or adult. Always at least two of us in the room.
- ✦ **Small, supervised groups.** We keep group sizes small on purpose, so every student is accounted for.
- ✦ **We follow your rules.** Your building, your guidelines. Our volunteers follow your site's policies, sign-in procedures, and emergency plans while we are guests in your space.

Prepared for the unexpected

- ✦ A first-aid kit is on site at every workshop, and we know your building's exits and emergency procedures before we start.
- ✦ Any injury or concern is written down and the student's parent or guardian is told right away.
- ✦ If a volunteer ever notices something that worries them about a student's safety, they raise it with the adult on site immediately.

OUR SAFETY PROMISE TO HOST SITES

Every student is signed up by a parent. An adult is always present. Volunteers are never alone with a student. We follow your building's rules, and we leave your space exactly as we found it. If you ever have a safety question or concern, we will answer it before you commit to anything.

Want to see the paperwork? We are happy to share our parent consent form, our volunteer rules, and our full safety plan before you say yes. We would rather you feel completely comfortable than rush a decision.

What it looks like in your space

Roughly two hours, start to finish. Here is the shape of a typical workshop so you know exactly what to expect.

Before	We arrive early to set up, check the room, and confirm everything with your contact.
Doors	Students arrive, grab a snack, and find their group. Parents drop off.
Workshop	Volunteers run the hands-on activity. The main event, fully supervised.
Show & tell	Students share what they made. Lots of cheering.
Wrap	Parents pick up. We pack up, clean up, and leave the room as we found it.

We are flexible

- ✦ Flexible on dates. We work around your calendar and your busy times.
- ✦ Flexible on topics. From coding to art to engineering, we match the workshop to your space and audience.
- ✦ Flexible on age range and group size, so it fits the families you serve.

Find us a date

If you have a room and a free weekend, we would love to find a time that works. There is no commitment in reaching out. We can answer every question, share our safety paperwork, and only move forward when you are ready.

- 1 Email us and tell us a bit about your space and possible dates.
- 2 We will reply with answers, our safety materials, and a proposed plan.
- 3 We lock in a date, we show up prepared, and your community gets a great free event.
