THE ASK, UP FRONT

We keep our workshops free for every student. That only works because local partners chip in. Whether it is a few dollars, a box of snacks, some hand-me-down laptops, or a room on a Saturday, every bit of support goes straight to students. This packet shows what we do, who it helps, and the easy ways you can be part of it.

What StudentTeachers is

The short version. StudentTeachers runs free, hands-on workshops that let young students try out real careers, from coding to medicine to art, before they ever have to pick a path. It is built and run by high schoolers, on weekends and online, here in Illinois.

Why it matters. Most students do not get to explore careers until the decisions already feel rushed. We move that discovery earlier, when it can actually shape what a kid believes is possible for them.

Why it is different. The people teaching are barely older than the people learning. That peer-to-peer setup makes careers feel reachable instead of intimidating, and it gives high school volunteers real leadership experience at the same time.

Host	A room for a couple of hours on a weekend, plus tables, chairs, and ideally a screen	Recognition as a community host site, a feel-good event in your space, and our deep gratitude

Numbers above are starting suggestions, not rules. **If you want to help and none of these fit, just tell us what works.** We will figure it out together.

Where your support goes

We run lean and everything goes to students. Here is what support actually pays for.

What we spend on

- ✦ **Materials.** The hands-on supplies that make each workshop work, from craft materials to project kits.
- ✦ **Devices.** Laptops and Chromebooks so students who do not own one can still join coding and design workshops.
- ✦ **Snacks.** Every workshop includes them. Hungry students do not learn, and it helps kids show up.
- ✦ **Space.** When a free venue is not available, a little funding helps us rent a room so a workshop can still happen.
- ✦ **Basics.** Small operating costs like printing, a website, and the occasional guest speaker thank-you.

A REAL EXAMPLE

A single box of snacks covers a whole workshop. A few used laptops let a class full of kids build their first website. Sponsoring one full session puts an entire weekend of free, hands-on learning in front of a room of local students. Small support goes a long way here.
